



Put the dominos face down on the table and mix them up. Each player takes 6 dominos; for a game with more than 3 players, each player should draw 3 dominos. The remaining dominos are left on the table. In traditional dominos, the person with the highest double starts. For us, the person with the most Easter Bunnies goes first. The first player places one of their dominos (right-side up) on the table. The second player tries to put a domino on the table that matches on side of what's already there. If a player cannot go, the player picks a domino from the pile and skips that turn. Continue taking turns putting dominos on the board (or picking one from the pile if you cannot go) until someone wins. The winner is the first person to get rid of all of their dominos, but if no one can go out, then the person with the fewest dominos left is the winner.
